FILE EXTENSIONS: To create a more streamlined workflow with fewer technological hurdles, please name supplied art and page layout files with a correct file extension. This is especially important for files to be used across platforms (Mac to PC or vice versa).

(Formats .pct, .pcx, .gif and .bmp are accepted. However, they are NOT recommended, and some require manual conversion which could add cost to your job.)

PIXELS: Image files (.psd, .tif, .jpg, .bmp, Photoshop saved .eps) need to be supplied at a DPI (dots per inch) that is TWICE the size of the output. Our plates are imaged at 150-line screen so the recommended and preferred DPI of supplied files should be 300 DPI (minimum). Images can be sized down if supplied in correct DPI but CANNOT be sized up greater than 125% without loss of integrity of the image. When images are sized up, pixels are mathematically added to the image to increase the size, thus blurring the image.

FILE COLORS

RECOMMENDED

CMYK • Grayscale
 Spot Colors • Duotones • Monotones

NOT RECOMMENDED

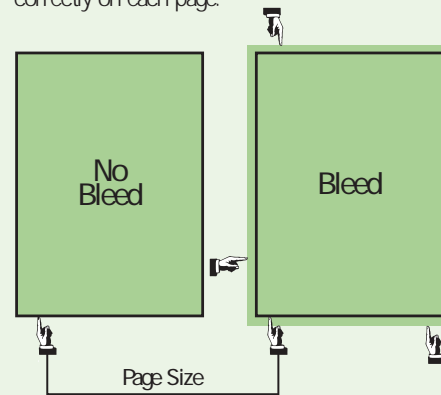
RGB • Index colors • Lab colors

RGB files will print, but an electronic conversion to CMYK occurs automatically, which causes a color change. Output cannot be adjusted.

BLEED

BLEED: Ink coverage on a file that is a minimum of 0.125 inches (1/8") larger than the actual trim size of the document's border

Full-bleed documents must be set up with bleed on all four sides of the live area. If a document is built with facing pages, please make sure that the top, bottom and side opposite the spine bleed correctly on each page.

FONTS

We require only fonts used in the document. The preferred method of collecting fonts is to "Collect for Output" in Quark or "Package" the document in InDesign. This will automatically collect all fonts and artwork into individual folders.

If this cannot be achieved, then the fonts used in the document should be organized into separate "family" folders.

(eg, Helvetica Roman, Italic, Bold and Bold Italic should be put together into a Helvetica folder.)
